



PAYMENT OPTIONS & TUITION INFORMATION

Total Camp Tuition Fees: \$595

\$195 non-refundable first payment due within 2 business days of enrolling - electronic invoice sent typically within 1 business day (if electronic invoice is delayed, the payment will be due within 1 business day of invoicing).

Important Invoicing and Payment Notes:

1. Initial Payment via Invoice - payments will be due within 1 business days of enrolling (invoices sent the next business day after enrolling) For example, for enrollments on Mon., Jan 27, payments would be due by Wed., Jan. 29 via an invoice (sent Tues., Jan 27). This will allow us to address any credits on your student's account + ensure the amount is credited to the student immediately upon payment.
2. Payment due dates:
 1. First Payment - \$195 - Due within 2 business days of enrollment (via invoice)
 1. This fee is non-refundable once paid to secure spot in camp.
 2. Second Payment - \$200 - Due March 1 (sent 2/20)
 1. As of March 2, \$395 is non-refundable.
 3. Third Payment - \$200 - Due April 1 (sent 3/20)
 1. As of April 2, no portion of fees are refundable.
3. Refunds will be processed as a credit on your student's account unless there is a request for a "cash" refund - these credits do not carry a processing fee deduction and do not expire - so you can use them for future programming. No matter what refund period a student withdraws, a 5% processing fee will be deducted for any "cash" refunds, which are provided via a mailed, physical check (we do not store credit card information, so refunds come in check form and take 4-6 weeks for processing).
4. With final payments due by April 1, in order to ensure waitlisters eager to get a spot in camp fill all open spots, we may unenroll any students (who have not made prior arrangement) who are not paid in full as of April 5, 2025. We will follow-up multiple times before this occurs, but please communicate with us well in advance if you have a situation that requires additional time to pay. This helps us ensure spots that ultimately will not be used be made available to waitlisters earlier in the spring.

- \$195 first payment due within 2 business days of enrollment
 - For Early Access - Sent 1/28, Due Wed., Jan 29 (if payment isn't recieved by this date, we will offer the spot to a waitlister)
 - For Public Enrollment - Sent 2/4, Due Wed., Feb 5 (if payment isn't received by this date, we may offer the spot to a waitlister)
- \$200 due March 1 (invoices sent electronically February 20) - \$395 non-refundable as of March 1
- \$200 due April 1 (invoices sent electronically March 20) - \$595 non-refundable as of April 1

LATE ENROLLMENT TUITION INCREASES

If you register between...Feb 1 - April 1 - tuition is \$595

INCREASE April 2 - May 1 - tuition increases to \$625; May 2 - Start of Camp - tuition increases to \$650

International Thespian Festival & Summer Conflicts

International Thespian Festival – June 22-27, 2025

For students who qualify for this, they are still able to participate in our camp. It is absolutely critical that any other summer conflicts be minimized as much as possible to ensure a student is available for the vast majority of rehearsal, given that this is a large conflict.

Students who have qualified for ITF need to include all days they are missing on their audition form as conflicts will be locked this year and (outside a medical emergency), additional conflicts after casting will likely not be accommodated. We will work hard to adjust our schedule around this week since it's a known conflict, but need to know who is impacted ahead of casting.

Summer Conflicts & Casting – Elementary, Middle and High School

If your student chooses to audition, it is CRITICAL you capture all summer conflicts in your audition form at the time of auditioning. Updates will be allowed during Callbacks week – but once the cast list is posted, they are locked. In past years SRPA has unfortunately been misled by student availability, and thus, our policies are becoming more strict.

Students auditioning for other summer theatre MUST include Stage Right conflicts to ensure that theatre can work around them. It is not fair for a student to audition for multiple groups, with overlapping dates, not include conflicts, and expect all theatres involved to work around their conflicts added after casting. We've had great conversations around the community with other youth AND community theatre leaders about this issue. Help us help you!

In 2025, should a student be cast in a role and attempt to add additional conflicts that were not included during the audition process in order to appear more available, we may have to have a parent, student and staff conference to discuss the situation, which may result in the role being reassigned to another student. This will be a case-by-case situation and only escalated in instances where the intent was to mislead the casting panel.
